QUALIFICATIONS

- The qualifying material must be installed in a residential Minnesota building served with natural gas from Great Plains Natural Gas Co. (Great Plains).
- All attic insulation projects require the customer to have a residential energy assessment performed on their home prior to the insulation installation project. The energy assessment must be through the Great Plains Residential Energy Assessment program. A copy of the assessment must be included with the application.
- Attic insulation must be performed by a contractor; the rebate does not apply to self install projects.
- This program applies to existing homes only; and does not apply to garages or new construction.
- To qualify for this program, the existing R-value of attic insulation must be less than R-25 and the ending R-value must be greater than R-49.
- Rebates will be paid out at 50% of the project cost up to a maximum of \$150 for attic insulation.
- Great Plains reserves the right to verify completed jobs prior to payment of a rebate.
- Materials purchased and installed prior to January 1 of the plan year will not qualify for a rebate.
- Dealers/Contractors are not eligible to receive their customer's rebate.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The rebate application form must be submitted within 90 days of installation date or postmarked by December 31 of the plan year whichever comes first.
- Application must be completely filled out with purchaser information, contractor information (including a copy of the contractor sales invoice) and energy assessment report.
- Great Plains is unable to accept applications that do not include all this information.
- It is the responsibility of the contractor and purchaser to ensure that the installed material qualifies for the rebate.
- If the material does not qualify, no rebate will be paid.

REBATE DETAILS

Rebate qualifications and amounts are subject to change. Rebate funds are limited. Completed rebate forms will be processed in the order in which they are received. Great Plains CIP rebate programs may be cancelled or changed at any time.

The rebate application form must be postmarked by December 31 of the plan year for the rebate to be processed. Rebates will not be paid if funds are depleted prior to December 31.

Rebate amounts will be issued for material installed between January 1 and December 31 of the plan year only. Great Plains issues rebates in the form of a check, not utility bill credits. Great Plains is not responsible if the dealer does not provide accurate information about the amount of rebate or eligibility requirements. Allow 4-6 weeks for rebate processing.
