

# Gas Utility Infrastructure Cost Adjustment Rate Effective March 1, 2019

On April 13, 2018, Great Plains Natural Gas Co. (Great Plains) filed with the Minnesota Public Service Commission (MNPUC) to update its Gas Utility Infrastructure Cost (GUIC) tariff, which allows Great Plains to recover the cost of infrastructure investments mandated by federal and state agencies associated with Great Plains' pipeline integrity and safety programs such as the cost of assessments, modifications and replacement of natural gas facilities that are not included in the base rate. The GUIC was initially approved by the MNPUC on October 6, 2017, and the update was approved on February 12, 2019.

The per dekatherm adjustment charge approved in the GUIC filing is shown by customer class in the table below. The GUIC is reflected as a separate line item on your monthly gas service statement and will be effective with service rendered on or after March 1, 2019.
