**DO YOU NEED ASSISTANCE TO
MANAGE YOUR MONTHLY GAS BILLS
AND PAY PAST-DUE BALANCES?**

Great Plains Natural Gas Co. offers its Minnesota customers a Gas Affordability Program (GAP) that helps qualified customers manage their monthly gas heating bills and pay past-due balances.

To qualify for GAP, applicants must receive a Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) grant for the current heating season payable to Great Plains Natural Gas Co. To apply for LIHEAP, contact the agency serving your community, listed in this brochure.

GAP offers qualifying customers two types of credit:

- 1. Monthly Affordability Credit for current natural gas charges: A customer’s monthly natural gas charges will be averaged for the year. Those qualified will receive a monthly credit so their annual gas bill will not be more than 4% of their household income.
- 2. Matching GAP Installment Credit for past-due natural gas charges: Great Plains will set up a GAP Installment Plan to help a customer pay-off past-due bills over a period of up to 24 months. Each month paid towards the customer’s GAP Installment amount, a matching GAP credit will be applied to their account. If monthly payment are made, the customer will be paying for only one-half of the past-due balance.

GAP applications and more information are available from any of the Energy Assistance agencies serving Great Plains’ customers and through Salvation Army.
