

Infrastructure Cost Adjustment Rate Effective November 1, 2017

On December 21, 2016, Great Plains Natural Gas Co. (Great Plains) requested the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MNPUC) for approval of a Gas Utility Infrastructure Cost (GUIC) tariff. The establishment of the GUIC adjustment tariff will allow Great Plains to recover out-of-test-year infrastructure investments mandated by federal and state agencies associated with Great Plains' pipeline integrity and safety programs such as the cost of assessments, modifications and replacement of natural gas facilities. The GUIC was approved by the MNPUC on October 6, 2017.

The per dekatherm adjustment charge approved in the GUIC filing is shown by customer class in the table below. The GUIC is reflected as a separate line item on your monthly gas service statement and will be effective with service rendered on or after November 1, 2017.
