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## RATE INCREASE NOTICE

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR GREAT PLAINS NATURAL GAS CO. MINNESOTA CUSTOMERS



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Great Plains Natural Gas Co. (Great Plains) has asked the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MPUC) for approval to increase its rate for natural gas distribution service. The requested increase is for approximately 12 percent per year or \$2,860,839. If approved, this increase will add about \$7.05 to an average residential customer's monthly bill.

The MPUC may either grant or deny the requested changes, in whole or in part, or may grant a lesser or greater increase than requested for any class or classes of service.

The MPUC is expected to make its decision on our rate increase request in 2020. If final rates are lower than interim rates, we will refund customers the difference with interest. If final rates are higher than interim rates, we will not charge customers the difference.

## PUBLIC HEARINGS

Administrative Law Judge Ann O'Reilly is holding two public hearings on the company's proposal. Any Great Plains customer or other person may attend or provide comments at the hearings. You are invited to comment on the adequacy and quality of Great Plains service, the level of rates or other related matters. You do not need to be represented by an attorney to provide comments during the public hearings.
